OUR 2023 GOAL: \$70,000

1. Help us meet our ANNUAL BUDGET:

In order to keep Christian education affordable, the tuition at many private schools is not enough to cover annual operating costs. This creates a "tuition gap." Income from tuition being less than expenses. This gap widens as we offer discounts, scholarships, and financial aid. By giving through our RAISING LIONS campaign, you will help us meet our budget needs for the 23-24 school year. **This need is \$50,000**.

2. Help us fund global & local MISSION & SERVICE projects:

We will take 10% of the Raising Lions campaign total funds raised to fund global and local mission and service projects. We are cheerful givers and we want to RAISE LIONS who are also cheerful givers.

The total amount for this goal will be 10% of the total funds raised. If we meet our goal and raise \$70,000, \$7,000 will be put towards these service projects.

This funding will allow us to teach our students the joy of giving through various projects- the first mission project being a Feed the Hunger Packathon. The Feed the Hunger Packathon will cost us \$3,628.80.

Our 2nd step will be to assess the amount that remains after Feed the Hunger to determine other mission and service projects to conduct alongside our students.

3. Help fund our NEW INITIATIVES:

As we hope you have heard, BCA has launched several new initiatives: a High School program, an Athletics Department, and new Enrichment programs. We are thankful to have the opportunity to say "yes" to these initiatives through the work of many servant-minded individuals. These programs are needed, they are important, and they are a blessing to our students and families. A few examples of things needed include: girls volleyball & other sport equipment, music & art supplies, summer camp supplies, and gym rental fees.

We have also ramped up safety and security measures at BCA. We are working on getting more staff certified in CPR, meeting with local law enforcement to ensure we are going the extra mile for security, and purchasing safety and security equipment that will help with continued improvement.

The exact amount to go towards NEW INITIATIVES will depend on the total amount received.
